## Health and Safety Policy Statement

The Company shall also manage its Health and Safety Management System in line with OHSAS 18001 and maintain third party accreditation from UK CARES.

In pursuance of compliance of legislation and that in which we subscribe, the company shall endeavour to:

- Provide Safe access to and egress from the workplace.
- Provide and maintain a safe place to work for all staff whilst at work.
- Provide safe plant and equipment which is maintained and inspected.
- Provide safe environment for employees, clients and visitors.
- Ensure the health and safety of all employees in connection with the use, handling, storage and transport of equipment and substances.

- Offer opportunities for consultations with employees.
- Provide instruction, information, training and supervision.
